## Students

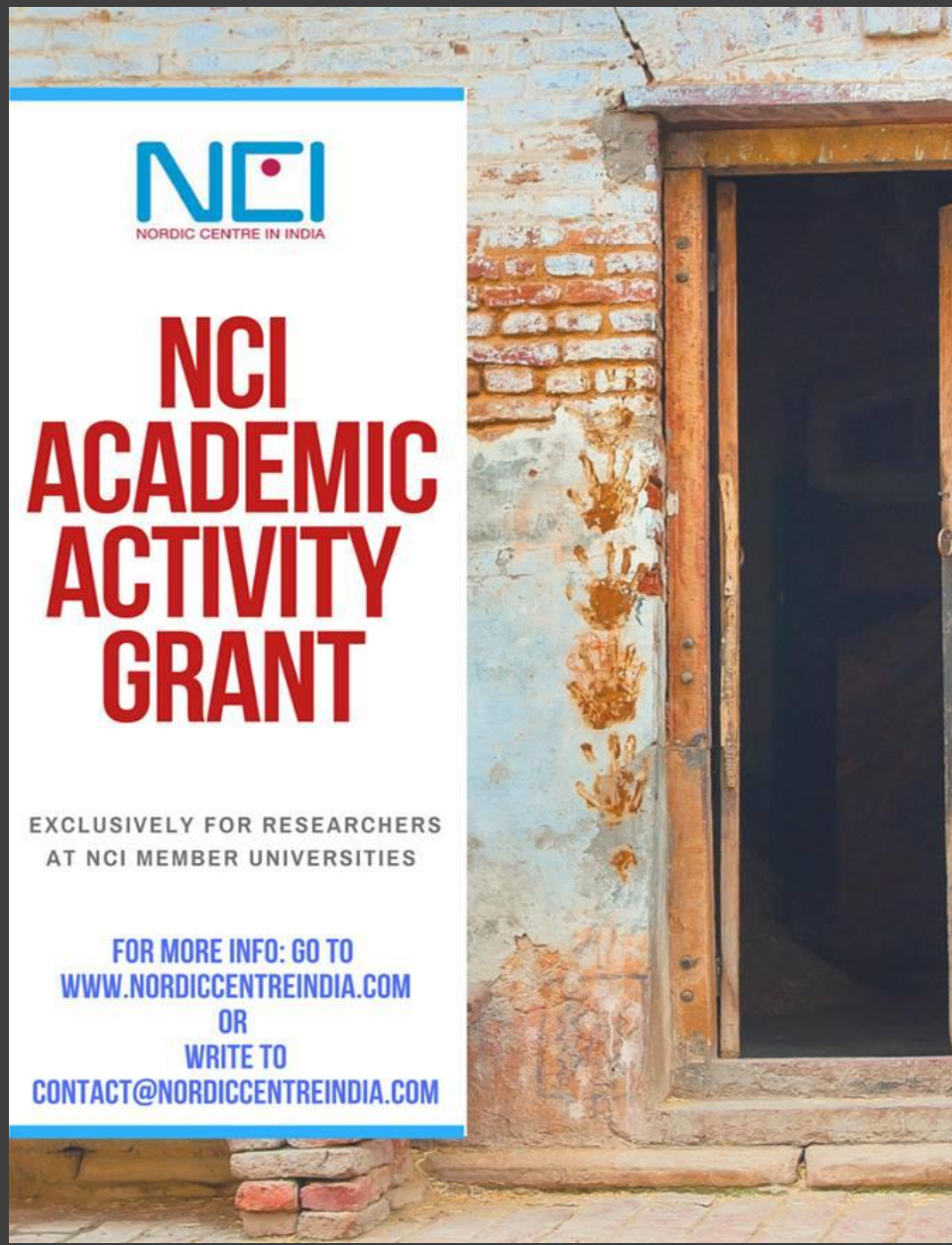
